SUMMARY OF THE YEAR

January A blustery beginning with gales rain and hail from 1st-3rd revealed a lone Velvet Scoter near Merkland, but Eider were courting at Corrygills by 12th. The advent of snow and frost from 14th caused an amazing total of 67 Stonechats to inhabit the shore levels along with 2 Snow Buntings at Sannox while 3 Snow Buntings kept a Ptarmigan company on Goatfell on 16th. This big weather movement followed by thunder, gales and more snow and frost brought some unusual visitors to bird tables such as Crossbill, Snow Bunting, Brambling and Rook. 15 Brambling in Glen Cloy and 10 Snow Bunting at Clauchlands Hill delighted observers on 24th. Snow also caused a Golden Eagle to come down to the String at Dereneneach. 200 Redwings and Fieldfares were at Auchencairn and 300 at Kildonan on 22nd. Biggest surprise also on 22nd must be a Coot on rocks in the sea at Whiting Bay blown over from mainland by a south east gale. 2 Great Northern Divers, 59 Red-breasted Mergansers and 32 Shags also sought shelter. 2 White-fronted Geese were unexpected in North Glen Sannox on 27th and the wintering Greylags reached 500 in Shiskine on 31st, having eaten Robertsons' grass and carrots.

February A Grey Plover appeared at Lamlash from 24 Jan - 6 Feb. Also on 6th an unexpected Tufted Duck visited Brodick Pier briefly. An oil slick off Kildonan on 10th killed many seabirds including 15 Razorbills, a few Guillemots and Gulls, while a Great Northern Diver was cleaned and looked after by Tony Church at Lochranza. 2 Purple Sandpipers were at Blackwaterfoot on 26th and 400 Rooks was a big number at Shiskine while a pair of Golden Plover on territory near Loch Nuis with song and courtship display gave a delightful lift to February. 2 Redpolls were at Marnaheglish on 29th and 2 Lesser Black-backed Gulls arrived back at Lamlash. Rain, hail and wind prevailed at the beginning of the month with a mild spell from 9th-19th, then back to the cold east wind which was the main feature although there were some sunny mild days.

March As expected March contained much wind, but was mainly dry with some mild spells which encouraged the Herons to start nest building early at Lamlash. A pair of Sparrowhawks gave the inmates a fright at an aviary in Whiting Bay on 10th. A Glaucous Gull followed the ferry on 15th and remained at brodick for 2 months. 14 Yellowhammers were still in a flock at Kilmory on 18th while 12 Shelduck fought for territory at Kildonan. A Merlin was discovered at Corrie on 19th and a Pochard at Lamlash on 21st. A Barn Owl was at Largybeg on 24th and 2 early Wheatears arrived at Cleiteadh on 25th. In late March 6 Golden Eagles, while being a magnificent sight, were viewed with mixed feelings as meaning they were unlikely to be breeding.

April April began with a cold north east wind which continued cold but fair. The first of what proved to be an exciting month found an Iceland Gull at Whiting Bay which remained until 12th May and a Magpie (rare for Arran) at Kings Cross for most of April until it decided to visit Lamlash and Lagg. Chiffchaffs were late with none heard until 11th at Brodick and a Willow Warbler at Kings Cross on 13th. 20 Quail were most unusual feeding in a field at Bennecarrigan on 13th and 14th and a shy Water Rail was discovered at Clauchlands. On 14th a strong south wind caused a Roseate Tern to fish close in at a sheltered bay in Pirnmill, a Common Sandpiper to arrive at Catacol, 2 White Wagtails to be at Kildonan and a Yellow Wagtail to be at Brodick. 15th saw the arrival of a Black Redstart at Lamlash and a Swallow at Strathwhillan. A Common Redstart was singing at North Glen Sannox on 19th and a female Goosander was at Loch Iorsa. On 20th a now scarce Moorhen was at Brodick, the first Cuckoos were heard at Kildonan and Glen Rosa, while the last Fieldfares were departing. Warmer weather coupled with clear skies on 22nd brought a Tree Pipit to Kings Cross, and a House Martin to Lamlash. Sedge Warblers had reached Bennan and a pair of Ring Ouzels were at Catacol by 29th. During the month there was the usual movement of Divers mainly in Kilbrannan Sound with three species seen. The month closed on 30th with the arrival at Kings Cross of a Blackcap.

May A continuation of high pressure allowed the main arrivals of summer visitors to take place. A Wood Warbler arrived at Brodick on 1st, a Whinchat near Corrie on 2nd while 2 Roseate Terns were at Dougrie on 5th. A Spotted Flycatcher came to Brodick and a

Whitethroat to Whiting Bay on 6th, although numbers of Hirundines remained low until well into the month. An out of season Grey Plover turned up at Dougrie on 9th and an interesting male Goosander at Machrie on 12th. A Garden Warbler was at North Sannox on 18th but only 2 Sand Martins had arrived at Dougrie by 19th. A Sanderling was on passage at Blackwaterfoot on 20th with 3 at Machrie on 31st. A male Hen Harrier killed a Blackbird at Lamlash on 23rd which startled more than a few observers. Swifts first appearance was at Kildonan with 4 on 29th.

June Blazing June lived up to its name in part only, as cooler weather with rain occurred on 10 of the days. Terns were in view on 1st with 4 Common Terns at Pirnmill, 2 Sandwich Terns at Kildonan and 6 Arctic Terns at Machrie-Dougrie. Only 4 Arctic Terns present at Machrie is a big drop from 24 in 1983. Nightjars were late in arriving with the first not heard in Brodick until 5th, however, they later appeared, thankfully, in their usual numbers. A rarity in the form of a possible Black Wheatear caused a stir at Blackwaterfoot on 11th-15th. A lone Pink-footed Goose was at Catacol from 20th-26th. A Grasshopper Warbler, at Brodick during the month, was the only one heard. Being non-breeders Swifts are always interesting with 12 scything through the still warm air on 22nd. A Buzzard with a snake dangling winged its way over the Boguillie on 30th, and the month ended quietly with a Barn Owl asleep in a rock crevice at Machrie.

July Basking in some really hot sun, July was quiet, although some movement occurred on 7th when off Brodick, seen from the ferry were a Leach's Petrel, 4 Storm Petrels and 2 Great Skuas. Blackwaterfoot produced a solitary Bar-tailed Godwit on 16th and a Corncrake (sadly a declining species) which had also been heard in Lamlash. 9 Buzzards soared in the Ross on 22nd with 7 in one thermal. The leucistic Thrush showed up in Lochranza for 2 days and a leucistic "Hoodie" was at Kings Cross on 24th. A Knot was in full summer plumage at Machrie on 25th while small numbers of Swifts were again seen with 14 at Lamlash on 29th.

August August turned out to be lively in spite of the drought which continued until 28th. 10 Sandwich Terns including juveniles were on passage at Clauchlands on 5th remaining for 6-8 weeks. 1000 Gannets were giving spectacular diving displays in Kilbrannan on 7th. 40 Long-tailed Tits was a fair number at Auchencairn on 8th. The Brodick-Ardrossan crossing again revealed 4 Storm Petrels and 20 Guillemots on 11th-12th. 3 Black Guillemots were at Whiting Bay on 14th and 3 Knot at Kildonan on 17th. Kittiwakes began to trickle into Whiting Bay with 8 on 15th building to 50 on 17th and good numbers immatures at Sannox on 19th. An early male Goldeneye was at Kings Cross Point on 18th and 15 Redpolls were feeding at Kings Cross on 21st, which also held good numbers of Hirundines with 100 on 24th. Machrie showed some passage with a Greenshank, 8 Dunlin and 3 Knot on 25th, and a lonely Fulmar chick in nest on 26th. A flock of 100 Siskins rounded off the month at Gortonallister on 30th.

September Passage continued on 1st-3rd with 2 White Wagtails, 5 Grey Wagtails at Clauchlands with minimum 1000 Pied Wagtails round entire island. A Great Skua followed the ferry to Brodick on 2nd while 1 on the shoreline at Catacol on 9th was a surprise, and another was south east of Kildonan on 11th. Tawny Owls were hooting at new locations on 4th at Catacol and Whiting Bay. Also on 4th a northerly gale brought a big movement of Manx Shearwaters up Kilbrannan Sound with 1000 in 1 hour. During another large passage of Manx Shearwaters on 9th off Pladda, a Cory's Shearwater was seen. If accepted this would be a 1st record for Arran. An incredible 14 Buzzards soared above the Ross eastern hills on 5th and 12 Red-legged Partridges were at Dougrie on 6th. A Peregrine at Kings Cross on 8th mobbed by Starlings, turned and half-heartedly attacked one but was obviously not interested. Also on 8th the last Spotted Flycatcher was at Brodick. A Bar-tailed Godwit was at Torrylinwater Foot on 11th, the same date and place as last year while Guillemots peaked at 500 at Kildonan. A small passage of 12 Golden Plover occurred in Glen Chalmadale on 17th and a male Pintail was unusual at Kings Cross Point on 19th. A large movement of all adult Gannets took place past Corrie on 21st with 1000 south in 2 hours. On 23rd an unfortunate adult Peregrine died after collision with overhead wires while a Greenshank and 12 Twite were at Blackwaterfoot.

October October began with a mild spell and some warm north west winds on 4th and 5th. The last 2 Sandwich Terns were in Lamlash Bay on 2nd while Whiting Bay held 98

Red-breasted Mergansers. Auks figured more frequently with a rare Little Auk off Catacol on 7th, 4 Puffins off Laggan on 9th, 1 off Lochranza on 11th and many Guillemots and Razorbills round the island during the month. A Common Scoter was uncommon at North Sannox on 8th while on 9th a Greenshank remained at Machriewaterfoot and a solitary Black Grouse above Laggan was the only one seen during the year. Winter visitors were arriving with flocks of 100 Redwings at Kilmory and Kings Cross on 8th, a Brambling at Clauchlands on 9th and 8 Bramblings at Lochranza on 11th. The last 2 Wheatears were at Clauchlands on 7th and 2 Corn Bunting was a real find at Brodick for a species not recorded on Arran for over quarter of a century. A Great Grey Shrike appeared at Gortonallister on 17th while the last 4 Swallows were at Whiting Bay on 18th. An exciting Kingfisher flew south past Clauchlands Point on 22nd and a passage of 12+ Blackcaps took place at Sannox from 23rd to the end of December, with only 1 Garden Warbler. 7 Great Northern Divers was a fair number at Dougrie on 24th. Small numbers of Greylags began to arrive at the end of the month.

November Early November was dominated by cold east winds but 8 late House Martins were still at Brodick on 3rd. A large fall of Thrushes occurred on 4th with 1500 Fieldfares and Redwings seeking food and shelter in Glen Cloy and a Kingfisher at Rosa Burn. Snow Buntings added a wintry touch with 3 on North Goatfell on 5th and 7 on Staccach Ridge on 26th. 8 Bar-tailed Godwits were revealed at Corrie on 11th and a Black Redstart at Brodick on 12th. Kildonan on 19th had 5 Red-throated Divers, 10 Yellowhammers and 8 Twites. Fulmars were on ledges at Bennan on 26th and 130 Shags were at Brown Head. Also on 26th, 2 White-fronted Geese were at Shiskine and numbers of Greylags reached 200 by end of the month which ended on a sad note with a dead Water Rail in Glen Rosa on 30th.

December Low pressure prevailed through most of the month with little movement in birds. 300 Rooks wintered at Shiskine, while wintering single Blackcaps were at Kildonan on 3rd and Whiting Bay on 18th. A Great Northern and a Red-throated Diver were in Whiting Bay on 9th while a pair of Dippers was at Glenashdale. 16th found 44 Teal at Cleiteadh, 15 Scaup at Slidderywater Foot and 50 Greenfinch at Kilmory. 2 Bullfinch were at Kings Cross on 18th and the leucistic Crow had taken up residence in Lamlash . 2 Mute Swans ended the year quietly at Lamlash on 31st.

Total 240 prs. Still expanding although few young. 1 young Machrie 26 Aug, 1 young Drumadoon 2 Sep, 2 prs Catacol 24 Sep. Late singles Drumadoon 24 Oct, Bennan 26 Oct. Many on ledges Bennan 26 Nov. CORY'S SHEARWATER: 1 N Kildonan 9 Sep is 1st Arran record (MHD, CA).

Max 1000 N Pladda in 1 hr 4 Sep; 600 S in 1 hr Kilbrannan 9 Sep; last 2 S Drumadoon 24 Oct.

STORM PETREL: 4 Ardrossan - Brodick 7 Jul; 4 off Brodick 12 Aug.

SHAG: Breeding: 10 prs Holy Isle 29 May Counts inc 15 imm, Bennan 29 Apr; 32 Whiting Bay 22 Jan; 28 Brown Head 26 Feb and 130 on 26 Nov; 30 Hamilton Rock most months; 60-100 Kildonan 17 Aug - 26 Nov.

GREY HERON: 22 nests with young: 8 Whitehouse Lamlash, 1 Lamlash with 2 young, lost 1 to a Buzzard; 7 Brodick Country Park; 2 Stronach Brodick, 2 Lagg, 1 Whiting Bay, 1 Machrie. Counts inc 5 Corrie - Brodick 12-17 Jul; 6 Loch a Mhulein often

seen.

MUTE SWAN: Pr Lochranza did not breed, joined by a single 20 Mar - 25 Apr; Pr. Lamlash Jan - 19 Mar, 27 Sep - 31 Dec; 1 Whiting Bay 10-18 Mar, 2 on 17-26 Dec; pr Machriewaterfoot 3 Apr sometimes seen Catacol is probably resident Lochranza pr; separate pr. Brodick 2 Sep - 21 Oct when usual pr at Lochranza.

WHOOPER SWAN: 30 S off Lamlash 27 Sep (AW).

PINK-FOOTED GOOSE: 1 Dunan Brodick joined domestic geese end June and has wintered: 1 Catacol 20-26 June could be same one.

WHITE-FRONTED GOOSE: 2 North Glen Sannox 27 Jan (AR); 2 Shiskine 26 Nov

(MHD).

GREYLAG GOOSE: 20 Kings Cross, 70 Clauchlands 25 Jan (same 70 Whiting Bay 4 Feb also seen other dates); Max 500 Shiskine 31 Jan, 213 on 4-31 Mar; last Spring 25 left 15 Apr. Arrived back in small numbers; 6 S Lochranza 8 Oct, 25 Shiskine 26 Nov built up to 200 by end Nov. Numbers down.

BUZZARD: Plentiful and seen most parts. 24 territories. Max 14 Ross Road 4 Sep. **GOLDEN EAGLE:** No young from 2 prs. Pr built 2 nests at one site but no eggs. Good spring and summer. 6 North Arran 15 Mar; pr Kildonan 20 Apr was unusual. Many other sightings over high ground.

KESTREL: Better year with 15 prs. Pr 3 well grown young Machrie 21 Jul; pr, 2 young Glen Catacol 27 Jul; nest Bennan late June; 4 Imachar 29 Jul; fledged young

Corriegills Jul.

MERLIN: At least 3 territories. Q Rubha Salach 19, 22 Mar; Q Kings Cross 4, 13 Apr; singles Machrie 25 May; Sannox 30 June; Catacol 4 Sep; Bennecarrigan 10 Oct; Shiskine 12 Nov.

PEREGRINE: 4 successful prs reared 14 young. Eggs found smashed at one site, possibly high in PCB's. 1 died Lamlash 26 Sep after collision with overhead wires.

WHITE-TAILED EAGLE: Wandering adult or sub-adult watched coming from Arran flew ashore 2 miles N of Ardrossan 12 Aug. This is the first record of the species in Ayrshire and Arran since 1881 and probably refers to one of the birds introduced on Rhum (R H Hogg).


