

INTRODUCTION

Every year has something to commend it and 1990 proved to be no exception. Although Arran is not renowned for waders we were fortunate enough to have attracted a rare visitor from America, a Long-billed Dowitcher, not often recorded in Scotland let alone Arran.

A grey shrike recorded at Drumadoon on 18 May was not identified definitely as Great Grey or the much rarer Lesser Grey, though the late spring date might be considered to favour the latter. Previous May/June records of a grey shrike have all been from the same stretch of coastal clifftop heath around Drumadoon and King's Cave. All were by different observers on the following dates: 8 June 1979; 6 June 1980; 4 June 1983. V M Thom in "Birds of Scotland" states that most records of Lesser Grey Shrike have been from mid-May to mid-June or mid-September to mid-October, most often in Fair Isle and Shetland, but also in other counties including Ayrshire and Argyll. A Lesser Grey Shrike was reported from Kirk Yetholm (Borders) on 5 May 1990 (Birding World Vol 3 no 5). Again according to Thom, most Great Grey Shrikes have left by the middle of May, with only occasional stragglers still present in June; nevertheless, the suggestion that a single returning bird may be involved is consistent with the known habits of this species.

Any further sightings of this bird, with detailed descriptions or even better a photograph,

would be welcomed.

It is cause for concern that our Golden Eagles have bred unsuccessfully for the last two years, whatever the reason, be it a shortage of suitable hunting terrain, insufficient prey to feed the young, or cold wet springs resulting in the young dying of hypothermia.

On a more hopeful note, however, Nightjars were heard in a new territory; this is

encouraging news of a declining species.

Also in 1990, some dedicated seawatching has resulted in more coverage of seabird

passage including records of petrels, shearwaters, auks and skuas.

The BTO/SOC/WC Breeding Birds Atlas has been extended for a further year and anyone willing to help with supplementary records should contact D Warner, Brodick Country Park. The BTO "Birds of Estuaries Enquiry" continues as do the Wildlife Counts. Thanks to all who helped with these surveys and to the many who supply the information for the bird report. We would also like to thank Mandy Cree, Audrey Walters, and Bernard Zonfrillo for their art work.

Please send all records for 1991 in Voous order (as in the Check List) by December 1991 or earlier. All records of vagrant or occasional species (see Check List) should be accompanied by a detailed description. CHRONOLOGICAL SUMMARY

JANUARY- MARCH

The mild spell at the beginning of the year found nothing more unusual than 2 Purple Sandpipers at Drumadoon on 1st January. A flock of 50 Siskins and 8 Redwings seemed happy to be at Kingscross Pt on the 2nd. 2 Little Grebes were found in their usual sheltered waters at Ardlui on the 6th, while on the 7th it was a surprise to find 20 Teal on Holy Isle and 48 Pied Wagtails at Sliddery. The first two Gannets of the year were not seen until the 19th off Whiting Bay. Windy weather on the 21st brought an exhausted Little Auk to Pirnmill where it was rescued and later released alive and well. Another, not so lucky, was found dead at Drumadoon on 4th February after prolonged gales. A Jack Snipe and 30 Teal were at Corriecravie on the 5th. 5 Black-throated Divers and a single male Goosander appeared in Whiting Bay on the 12th. 2 Barnacle Geese were discovered at Clauchlands on 1st March. Nothing of any import then turned up (or was the weather bad?) until the 18th when 2 early Wheatears appeared to brighten us up on Machrie golf course. At the same time 6 martins, most likely to be Sand Martins, were feeding over trees for 1 hour at Gortonallister. A cheering sound was the first Chiffchaff of the year singing at Lochranza on the 21st.

APRIL-JUNE

On 1st April 10 Purple Sandpipers were discovered at Drumadoon. 3 Pintail were unusual at Corriecravie on the 3rd. A few summer migrants arrived during the warmer weather on the 6th, such as a Whimbrel at Cordon and Tree Pipits on the Ross road. On the 8th 2 Sand Martins were at Auchencar. Due to a spell of cold and windy weather with rain, hail and sleet, no more migrants arrived until the more clement weather of the 19th, when 2 Sandwich Terns were at Brodick. A Corncrake was calling at Shiskine on the 20th, but was not heard again. The 22nd found a Common Sandpiper at Brodick, a Grasshopper Warbler at Torbeg, and a House Martin at Auchencairn. 2 White Wagtails appeared in Porta Leacach, and a Swallow at Kildonan on the 23rd when the first Cuckoo of the year was heard in Blackwaterfoot. At the beginning of May, temperatures soared to 80F. Migration was again apparent from the 5th, with a Wood Warbler in Brodick Country Park, a Whitethroat at Torbeg, Whinchats in Glenscorrodale on the 6th, and a Sedge Warbler at Kildonan on the 7th. A Blackcap was seen and heard at Kingscross and a Common Tern fished in Whiting Bay on the 9th. A Dotterel was present on the Western Hills from 9th to 11th; also on the 11th a Little Gull was a surprise in Whiting Bay, and 17 Whimbrel was a large number for this species at Kildonan. 7 Great Northern Divers resplendent in summer plumage appeared at Thundergay on the 12th. A Spotted Flycatcher was at Corrie on the 13th and 2 Arctic Terns which called in briefly at Machrie on the 14th did not stay. The first young Shelducks had emerged at Blackwaterfoot on the 21st and a lone Fieldfare lingered at North Sannox on the 27th. The first Nightjar arrived on the 27th and the first Swifts were seen at Sannox on the 28th. This concluded the arrival of summer migrants. June was a busy month for parent birds but nothing worthy of note was seen (Editors not present this month). A Long-eared Owl was a good find in Brodick on the 21st and 11 Greylag Geese were still present at Tormore on the 26th.

JULY-SEPTEMBER

A Tawny Owl with a juvenile in Brodick was a good start to the month on 1st July. In very strong southerly winds 1200 Manx Shearwaters in 1 hour were moving south past

Whiting Bay on the 4th; this was part of a large movement in the Firth of Clyde and Kilbrannan that continued throughout and after July. Storm Petrels too figured in this movement with 26 together off Dougrie on the 13th and 20 off Imachar on the 17th. 2 Puffins were seen on the Brodick to Ardrossan crossing on the 18th. 5 rather scarce Common Terns were at Whitefarland on the 19th. 15 Crossbills announced their presence on the 22nd by dropping pine cones on the head of a startled gardener at Auchencairn; these may have been part of an irruption of Crossbills from the European continent. A Sanderling in summer plumage was discovered at Pimmill on the 24th. August began quietly with a single Barnacle Goose - probably feral - sitting with gulls at St Molio's Cave, Holy Isle on the 4th. Events livened up slightly on the 14th when 15 Storm Petrels were seen between Brodick and Ardrossan. Also on that crossing a Great Skua appeared while 2 Whimbrel remained at Brodick. 3 vociferous Greenshanks called in at Machrie on the 19th while also present were a Sanderling, a Knot and a Whimbrel with 60 Ringed Plovers. Sandwich Terns visited many parts of the island during the month and on the 21st we were pleased to find 24 including juveniles at Lamlash, Whiting Bay and Kildonan. The month closed with the first Wigeon back at Machrie on the 31st. In September, which proved to be a lively month, 6 Sanderling were at Blackwaterfoot on the 2nd and 6 Goosander at Machrie on the 10th. At Pirnmill 2 Common Scoter, which are not common on Arran, flew north on the 12th while 3 White Wagtails were at Blackwaterfoot. A Merlin was pursuing a flock of Linnets at Cleats on the 14th. Undoubtedly the highlight of the year, a Long-billed Dowitcher, arrived at Sliddery on the 15th and remained until the 17th. The presence of a Curlew Sandpiper at the same location paled by comparison. With the Long-billed Dowitcher being a very special first record for Arran, it caused a great stir among local birders, and even brought over from the mainland a number of twitchers, who dipped out much to their disgust! A Great Skua was off Sliddery on the 18th. Strong gales at Pirmmill on the 19th drove close inshore 2 Leach's Petrels, 2 Storm Petrels and a Little Gull together with some 2000 Kittiwakes. A touch of winter on the 21st found 50 Greylag Geese flying SE at Kingscross while an Arctic Skua was at Imachar. A Grey Plover turned up at Clauchlands on the 23rd and a Great Skua was onshore at Machrie feeding on the carcass of a dead sheep. A Snow Bunting appeared at Glas Choirein (Western Hills) on the 24th and 8 Redwings were early at Machrie on the 26th.

OCTOBER-DECEMBER

October 1st found a White Wagtail still present at Whitefarland, and a single Purple Sandpiper at Cleats on the 5th. A large movement of seabirds N off Pirnmill on the 6th included a Little Tern, a Little Gull, and an Arctic Tern with thousands of gulls and Kittiwakes. The first 6 Fieldfares were at Pirnmill on the 12th. The 14th proved to be eventful when during a south-east gale a 'Balearic' Shearwater was with 8 Manx Shearwaters and an Arctic Skua at Corriecravie, a Common Scoter at the Cleats, a Grey Plover at Machrie, and a late Wheatear at Corriecravie. The last 2 Swallows were at Whiting Bay on the 15th. A Water Rail was disturbed from dense cover at Clauchlands on the 18th. A Pink-footed Goose had joined the Greylags at Machrie on the 22nd, at which date a Common Scoter was at Whitefarland and yet another Great Skua at Pirnmill. A very early (or late) Shelduck was at Kildonan on the 25th and 6 Whooper Swans which were discovered at Bennecarrigan on the 28th stayed on into the following month. November began with 2 Brent Geese at Kerr's Port and 2 Snow Buntings on Beinn Bharrain on the 1st. Single Little Grebes were in Blackwaterfoot harbour and Kerr's Port on the 2nd. 12 Crossbills were in the forestry above Shiskine on the 4th and by the 6th the number of Snow Buntings had risen to 10, this time on the Stacach Ridge. Also on

the 6th, 6 Waxwings at Shiskine brightened a winter day as they devoured cotoneaster and hawthorn berries hungrily, soon stripping the bushes in company with 300+ Fieldfares and Redwings. A Jack Snipe was at Clauchlands on the 8th. A Kingfisher delighted observers at Cloyburn Brodick on the 11th, coinciding with the departure of a late brood of House Martins from Kildonan. A Water Rail unfortunate enough to be caught by a cat at Catacol on the 24th was released unharmed. A Little Auk was unusual in calm waters at Lamlash pier on the 29th. December opened with a Snow Bunting on Brodick beach on the 1st. A large northward movement of auks in icy NE winds off Pirnmill on the 9th included surprisingly a Little Auk, 2 Little Gulls, and a Manx Shearwater. A male Blackcap was at a bird table in Kilmory on the 12th, 2 Red-necked Grebes showed up at Catacol on the 16th and 2 Whooper Swans flew over Machrie Moor on the 17th. A Moorhen, seldom seen on Arran, was discovered at Cloyburn on the 18th while a pair of Tufted Ducks were in the sea at Sliddery. A Gannet was battling against storm force winds at Whiting Bay on the 29th. A Whimbrel remained at Whitefarland, the 2 Brent Geese at Clauchlands and the Kingfisher at Cloyburn until the end of the year.

Red-throated Diver Only 3 sites visited. Site 1: 2 eggs hatched successfully and produced 2 well-grown young last seen 24 Jul; Site 2: pr with 1 yng 1 Aug; Site 3: pr 12 Jul. Highest counts: 16 Pirnmill 18 Jul; 10 Tormore 26 Sep; 8 Machrie 22 Oct; 6 Whitefarland 11 Nov; 4 Whiting Bay 27, 28 Nov; 3 Lamlash 30 Nov; 5 Imachar/Dougrie 5 Dec; 7 Thundergay 16 Dec.

Great Northern Diver Highest counts: 9 Catacol/Pirnmill 12 May, 7 Thundergay 12 May; 4 Machrie 22 Oct; 3 Pirnmill 9 Nov, 13 Dec, 5 on 15 Dec; 3 Tormore 13 Dec. Many singles and pairs present throughout year but only 3 summer records (1 Pirnmill 12, 17 Jun, 1 Catacol 24 Jul).

- * Little Grebe Ardlui: 2 on 6 Jan, still present 17 Feb, 21 Feb, 4 on 24 Feb, only 2 present 14 Mar; Blackwaterfoot: 1 in harbour 2 Nov; Kerr's Port: 1 from 2 to 7 Nov.
- * Red-necked Grebe Thundergay: first-winter 15, 16 Dec (TapRh,MHD,AW); Catacol: a different bird (probably also first-winter) 16 Dec (TapRh).

Fulmar 190 occupied sites is close to last year's total of 205. 2 yng Machrie 10 Aug, 28 Aug; 1 ad 1 juv Drumadoon 14 Sep. 2 dead (cause unknown) Machrie 21 May. No significant change.

Grey Heron 11 occupied nests, 10 yng recorded. Small numbers throughout yr; highest count 4 Machrie 5 Nov, 25 Nov.






